B. CONSIDERATION TO AWARD THE BID FOR A 4-WHEEL DRIVE 1/2 TON EXTENDED CAB CRANE SERVICE TRUCK

The City solicited bids for a 4-Wheel Drive 1-1/2 Ton Extended Cab Crane Service Truck for the Environmental Systems Division. Seven bids were received from vendors. Upon review of the information submitted with the bids, several of the bids have been determined to be non-compliant with the specifications. Staff is recommending awarding the bid to Power Equipment Company Bid #1, which includes an IMT utility body mounted on a Dodge chassis. The new vehicle will replace a unit that was recently sold at auction. The cost of the new truck will be \$156,798.64.

Suggested Motion: I move to award the bid for a new 4-wheel drive 1/2 ton extended cab crane service truck to Power Equipment Company Bid #1, in the amount of \$156,798.64.
