B. CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENT NO. 2 WITH BURNS & MCDONNELL ENGINEERING COMPANY

In December 2017 the City entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company for the design of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Replacement Facility. Since that time, Burns & McDonnell has performed the required design services for the proposed facility. As the completion of the design process approaches and the bidding and construction phases approach, we have negotiated a scope and fee for continuing professional services through the end of the project.

Suggested Motion: I move to approve Amendment No. 2 to the City's Agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc. for construction phase professional services for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Replacement Facility in the amount of \$1,664,306.

C. CONSIDERATION TO APPROVE AN AGREEMENT WITH TARGET SOLUTIONS FOR ONLINE POLICE TRAINING

The platform also gives the department a centralized location to schedule training, keep training records, and build personalized training courses utilizing Target Solution software and cloud storage. The agreement in question governs the purchase and ongoing use of the services provided by Target Solutions.

Suggested Motion: I move to approve the agreement between the City of Green River and Target Solutions allowing the Police Department access to Target Solutions online training courses, and authorize Mayor Rust to sign the agreement upon legal approval.
