A. CONSIDERATION TO APPROVE A RESOLUTION TO RENAME LINCOLN STREET TO LINCOLN CIRCLE

Recently it has come to the attention of the City of Green River Development Services Department that Lincoln Street has issues regarding addressing. The street sign shows Lincoln Street, the lots are addressed to Madison Avenue and the County MapServer refers to it as Lincoln Circle. This is confusing to emergency services such as EMS, Fire and Police as well as delivery drivers. To eliminate confusion and to ensure that emergency response is swift and accurate, staff

recommends eliminating Lincoln Street and to dedicate it as Lincoln Circle. New addresses will be required for the seven existing dwellings on the property in question.

Suggested Motion: I move to approve the resolution authorizing Lincoln Street to be named Lincoln Circle and for the Director of Community Development to create and assign addresses.
