Background/Alternatives:

The Green River Police Department applied for and was successful in being awarded a grant from the Wyoming Office of Homeland Security in the amount of \$45,954.00. This grant requires no matching funds from the City of Green River and is 100% reimbursable.

The Police Department worked with the Parks and Recreation Department and Finance to determine a number of projects that could be funded with the monies. New secure proximity card reader doors will be installed at City Hall, along with several at the Police Department that were not able to be done during initial construction. Funding will also be used to purchase and install numerous security cameras for the Police Department and Parks and Recreation Department.

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GREEN RIVER, WYOMING, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY LAW ENFORCEMENT TERRORISM PREVENTION ACTIVITIES GRANT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO APPROVE AN INCREASE IN THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR THE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,954.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to use the grant proceeds for the Police Department; **and**

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the grant from the Department of Homeland Security – Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities program; **and**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to increase the expenditure budget authority in the Capital Projects Fund for the purpose of funding the Police Department’s Homeland Security program (15.000.000.HMLDSC.60) in the amount of \$45,954; **and**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to increase the revenue budget authority in the Capital Projects Fund for the purpose of funding the Police Department’s Homeland Security program (15.000.000.HMLDSC.4810) in the amount of \$45,954;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE GOVERNING BODY ACCEPTS THE GRANT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY LAW ENFORCEMENT TERRORISM PREVENTION ACTIVITIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,954 FOR THE CITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZES AND DIRECTS THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE GRANT FOR SUCH PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZES THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND CITY TREASURER TO MAKE THE ABOVE CHANGES TO THE CITY BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2016.
