The City was awarded \$8,913.00 with \$50,150.00 matching funds from the City. This grant will be used for mosquito management and to help offset the seasonal staffing costs with the city-wide mosquito program. The City funds are those of which are currently budgeted; no additional funding is being requested.

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GREEN RIVER, WYOMING, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM WYOMING DEPARMTNET OF AGRICULTURE FOR INSECT MANAGEMENT, AND TO APPROVE AN INCREASE IN THE PARKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE MOSQUITO CONTROL DIVISION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,913

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the grant from the Wyoming Department of Agriculture for an Emergency Management Insect; **and**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to use the grant proceeds from the grant to abate/mange mosquitos by hiring two seasonal positions; **and**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body agrees to provide \$50,150 from wages and pesticides in matching funds in the form of wages and pesticides for the grant; **and**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to increase the expenditure budget authority in the General Fund Mosquito Control Division for the purpose of funding the mosquito control program (10.600.645.MCS.51.30) in the amount of \$8,913; **and**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to increase the revenue budget authority in the General Fund for MISC Grants (10.4810) in the amount of \$8,913;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE GOVERNING BODY ACCEPTS THE GRANT WITH THE WYOMING DEPARMTNET OF AGRICULTURE FOR INSECT MANAGEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$59,063, AND AUTHORIZES THE MAYOR TO SIGN SAID AGREEMENT, AND AUTHORIZES THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND CITY TREASURER TO MAKE THE ABOVE CHANGES TO THE CITY BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2018.

2018 Wyoming Emergency Insect Management Grant
Pre-Award Acceptance Letter

On April 24th, 2018 the Wyoming Emergency Insect Management Committee (EIMC) held a regular meeting and awarded the 2018 Emergency Insect Management grants. The City of Green River has been awarded a 2018 Emergency Insect Management grant for the program titled: City of Green River Mosquito Control. However the committee did not award the grant for the requested amount. In order for the Department of Agriculture to proceed with the contractual process, the City of Green River must give pre-approval to the funding levels awarded and agree to the additional contingencies the committee requires.

The City of Green River Requested the Following:

\$15,000.00 Grant Funds
\$84,400.00 Matching Funds

The EIMC approved the following:

\$8,913.00 Grant Funds
\$50,150.00 Matching Funds

The committee has placed the additional contingencies on the City of Green River as listed below:

- All grantees awarded funding \$3,000 or higher for programs including the management of adult mosquitos must implement Level 2 or Level 3 monitoring as defined in Appendix E of the grant application.
All expenses or purchases made before April 24th, 2018 are ineligible for reimbursement with EIMC grant funds nor can be claimed as matching funds. This includes expenses associated with attending the Wyoming Mosquito Management Association (WMMA) meeting in February, 2018 and the West Central Mosquito & Vector Control Association (WCMVCA) meeting in March, 2018.
Recommends the City of Green River sends a representative to the University of Wyoming Mosquito Monitoring training May 15th and May 16th. Register by calling 307-721-5258.
