

City of Green River, City Council Proceedings for July 10, 2018, 7 pm, Council Chambers, Mayor Pete Rust called the meeting to order. Council Member Barney moved to approve on third and final reading an Ordinance Amending Chapter 18 Offenses, Miscellaneous Provisions Section 18-90 – Unlawful Possession or Use of Tobacco Products by Minors. Council Member Berg seconded, motion carried. **Resolutions:** **(R18-19)** Consideration of a Resolution Declaring the Intent of the City of Green River to cooperate fully and assist Sweetwater County and the Incorporated Municipalities of Sweetwater County for the continuation of the county wide Lodging Tax. Council Member Wilson moved to approve the resolution declaring the intent of the City of Green River to cooperate fully and assist Sweetwater County and the Incorporated municipalities of Sweetwater County in taking all action necessary in support of the continuation of the existing county wide 3% Lodging Tax with an increase of 1%.
