

**CITY OF GREEN RIVER
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
May 11, 2010**

The Governing Body of the City of Green River met in special session at 6 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Castillon called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Council Members were present: Pete Rust, Ted York, Tom McCullough, Carl Morck, and Jim Boan. The following were present representing the City: City Administrator Barry Cook, Director of Community Development Laura Hansen, Director of Public Works Mike Nelson, Director of Human Resources Debbie Klein Robertson, Director of Finance Jeff Nieters Accounting Supervisor Chris Meats and Police Officer Chris Stephen. Public Information Coordinator Stephen Pyles, Recreation Supervisor Kevin Sadler and City Planner John Dahlgren were also present.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Council Member Boan moved to approve the agenda. Council Member McCullough seconded. Motion carried. (6-0)

COUNCIL ACTION ITEMS

Construction Engineering Services for the FMC Road Spur Project.

Council Member York moved to enter into a Professional Service Agreement with Inberg Miller Engineers for construction engineering services for the construction of the road and utilities for the FMC Spur Road Project in the amount of \$126,569. Council Member McCullough seconded.

City Administrator Cook stated Inberg Miller will oversee the project and be on sight to review all the work done on day to day bases. He explained the city received a consensus grant from the State of Wyoming through the SLIB process to upgrade the road and the infrastructure in the southeast part of the city going down to FMC Park. The first half has been completed which include the installation of water, sewer, and storm drains improvements. The continuation is to do a right angle off that road, join to the southeast on Mr. Jackman's property to the section line or the corporate limits of the city. This will open up two areas of development for future housing development. One track of land is owned by Jackman and the other is owned by the Green River Livestock Grazing Association. Staff felt for consistency sake, the city should continue on with Inberg Miller as construction engineering for the oversight of the project. The contract is for 120 days and should be completed by the end of summer.

Bid Award for FMC Park Spur Road Project

Council Member McCullough motioned to award the FMC Park Road Spur Project to Reiman Corp. in the amount of \$1,396,658.55 to and approve the agreement. Council Member Morck seconded.
