Mike Brown was nominated as vice chair of the board by Debbie Alvarez, and the motioned was seconded by Cathie Hughes. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Cathie Hughes was selected as treasurer.

The next board meetings were set for the first and third Thursdays at 6 p.m. at a place to be determined. Discussion moved to the board's first priority which is forming bylaws. Bylaws need to be formed before the board can file with the Wyoming Secretary of State's office. John will email the board with sample bylaws from other Wyoming Main Street boards [done October 28<sup>th</sup>].

John requests that each board member updates the newsletter with committee goings activities, usually by the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. Debbie volunteered to help deliver the newsletters, working alongside Mike and Dottie.

The only block declared to be blighted is the one that contains the Tomahawk Building (North 1<sup>st</sup> East / North 2<sup>nd</sup> East / Flaming Gorge / Railroad Ave). The blight study is done. John will send it out and the two surrounding blocks [done October 28<sup>th</sup>]. This will be reviewed at the next meeting.
