

**CITY OF GREEN RIVER  
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
November 10, 2011**

The Governing Body of the City of Green River met in special session at 6:30 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Castillon called the meeting to order and Dave Hanks led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Council Members were present: Gary Killpack, Tom McCullough, and Lisa Maes. City Administrator Barry Cook was present representing the City.

**APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

The Mayor noted an addition to the agenda of: “Support Your Own Spend At Home” Program for \$3,000.

Council Member Killpack moved to approve the agenda. Council Member McCullough seconded. Motion carried. (4-0)

**Support Your Own Spend at Home Program**

CEO of the Rock Springs Chamber of Commerce Dave Hanks presented the “Support Your Own Spend At Home” program promotes spending locally to improve the quality of life and bring money here to Sweetwater County. He said this program has changed a bit this year. They have received support from the local radio stations to provide local businesses radio time on a six month program. They have twenty-seven businesses that have bought the program and that totals \$17,000. The program has started already and will go through March of 2012. When money is spent here it stays here. The Mayor of the City of Rock Springs said he will support this program. Earlier this spring the line item in the County’s proposed budget for this was taken out so he is not sure if the county will support the program. They are asking for \$3,000 from the both cities.

Council Member McCullough moved to approve “Support Your Own Spend At Home” program for \$3,000. Council Member Maes seconded. Motion carried. (4-0)
