
# **GREEN RIVER FIRE DEPARTMENT ANNUAL FIRE REPORT 2008**

This report provides information regarding the activities of the Green River Fire Department. It contains information pertinent to the City of Green River and the patrons of the City. If you have any ideas or suggestions regarding additional information please give us a call at Fire Station 2 at 872-0545.

The Department consists of 32 volunteers and 2 full time personnel. We respond out of two stations, station 1 at City Hall and Station 2, located at the corner of Shoshone and Hitching Post. Our equipment is comprised of three pumpers, one pumper rescue, one quick attack rural rescue, one 93' Aerial Truck, one Haz Mat trailer, one antique 1946 Fire Truck, four suburban's; one for the Fire Chief, one for the Assistant Chief and one to transport personnel to fire schools and emergency calls, and one for the technical (rope-high angle) rescue response group.


Fire incidents for 2008 show a 15% increase in total incidents. The total Green River Fire Department's year-end report shows 327 incidents for 2008 as compared to 285 for 2007. The 327 incidents reflect all responses made by the Department including structure fires, vehicle fires, rescue/emergency medical calls, gas spills/leaks, false alarms, smoke scares, police assists, and carbon monoxide alarms.

The Fire Department responded to fires this year that caused an estimated property loss of approximately \$659,996.00, with \$400,000.00 of that amount being the reported loss to the Solvay Refinery roof. Because fire is always a potential problem, the Department will continue our Fire Prevention program in our schools, churches, businesses, and service and civic organizations in an effort to lower the fire loss in the City.

During 2008, the Green River Fire Department continued to present hands-on training with the portable dry chemical extinguishers. Participants included the employees of Castle Rock Ambulance Service, Castle Rock Medical Center, School District #2, Western Wyoming college Employees as well as our own City Staff and local Day-care providers. In addition, we presented fire prevention programs to the residents of Mansface Terrace and Green Rock Village. Fire prevention programs were also presented to the local elementary schools, to the public during Solvay Safety Day and station tours were conducted for many Scout groups, pre-school students and day care students. Several Infant Car Seat Inspection Sessions were held throughout the County and a monthly Safety Seat Saturday was implemented at Station 2 as a result of two firefighters being certified as car seat installation instructors. Through these programs the Green River Fire Department touched 3,413 people.

The Department also assisted at several events during Flaming Gorge Days, community events and High School activities and helped with live fire training for other departments in the state of Wyoming.

The firefighters of the Green River Fire Department held 36 regular meetings, 12 officer staff meetings, 12 hazardous material training sessions, 14 rescue/high angle training sessions, 41 public relations/fire prevention sessions, management training sessions, 30 Aerial Apparatus operations practices, 6 pumping/hose testing practices, 5 SCBA/CPR training sessions, miscellaneous sessions, along with attending regional fire training sessions. The Department held live burns/training sessions at the Fire Training Facility. A new recruit training class will begin on January 12, 2009 resulting in new firefighters for the department. This training will represent four hours each session one day each week for 18 to 20 weeks then an additional 40 hours of practical training to be State Certified as a firefighter 1.

This year we had eleven people with over 200 training hours, three firefighters with over 300 training hours. Two firefighters with 20 years of service, one firefighter with 25 years of service and one firefighter with 30 years of service.

This year we saw the formation of our Honor Guard, sadly because of the need to honor the loss of our fallen brother firefighters, but out of that sorrow and loss came a new branch of our service along with a color guard. The year saw the retirement of Chief Three and 30 years of experience leave our department. With all the changes including a new Chief, Assistant Chief, Captains, Lieutenants and new Firefighters it promises that 2009 will be a full and exciting year.


