# **GREEN RIVER FIRE DEPARTMENT ANNUAL FIRE REPORT 2010**


This report provides information regarding the activities of the Green River Fire Department. It contains information pertinent to the City of Green River and the patrons of the City. If you have any ideas or suggestions regarding additional information please give us a call at Fire Station 2 at 872-0545.

The Department consists of 31 volunteers and 3 full time personnel. We respond out of two stations, Station 1 at City Hall and Station 2, located at the corner of Shoshone and Hitching Post. Our equipment is comprised of three pumpers, one pumper rescue, one quick attack rural rescue, one 93' ladder platform Aerial Truck, one Hazardous materials response trailer, one antique 1946 Fire Truck, four suburban's; one for the Fire Chief, one for each of the Assistant Chiefs and the fourth that is used to transport personnel to fire schools and emergency calls and for the response of the technical (rope-high angle) rescue response group.

Fire incidents for 2010 show a 14% decrease in total incidents. The total Green River Fire Department's year-end report shows 229 incidents compared to 261 incidents for 2009 . The 229 incidents reflect responses made by the Department including structure fires, vehicle fires, rescue/emergency medical calls, gas spills/leaks, false alarms, smoke scares, police assists, and carbon monoxide alarms.


The Fire Department responds to fires in the Jamestown and Rio-Vista under a contract with the Jamestown Fire District, and Fires and emergency incidents in Sweetwater County when called for aid. The Green River Fire Department responds to aid Castle Rock Ambulance as extrication fire protection and special service assistance at all vehicle accidents, and extreme circumstance emergencies they are called to inside Sweetwater County and Castle Rock Ambulance response area. We also have a mutual aid agreement with the town of Granger and Fire District #1.

### Comparison of incidents per year from 2006-2010



The Fire Department responded to FIRES in 2010 that caused an estimated property loss of approximately \$801,130.00 with a little more than half of that amount being residential home fires. The estimated amount saved is \$1,929,000.00 due to the response of the fire department. Because fire is always a potential problem, the Department will continue our Fire Prevention program in our schools, churches, businesses, and service and civic organizations in an effort to lower the fire loss in the City.

### Comparison of Types of Calls for 2007 to 2010



During 2010, the Green River Fire Department continued to present hands-on training with the portable dry chemical fire extinguishers; Participants included employees of Castle Rock Ambulance Service, Castle Rock Medical Center, School District #2, Western Wyoming College Employees as well as our own City Staff and local Day-care providers. In addition, we presented fire prevention programs to the residents of Mansface Terrace and Green Rock Village. Fire prevention programs were also presented to the local elementary schools, and station tours were conducted for many Scout groups, pre-school students and day care students. Several Infant Car Seat Inspection Sessions were held throughout the County.

Through these fire prevention and fire education programs the Green River Fire Department touched **13,923** people.

The Department also assisted at several events during Flaming Gorge Days, community events, Chamber activities, High School activities and helped with live fire training for other departments in the state of Wyoming.

The Green River Fire Department held 32 regular training meetings, 13 monthly officer staff meetings, 15 hazardous material training sessions, 12 rescue/high angle training sessions, 72 public relations/fire prevention sessions, 13 management training sessions, 31 Aerial Apparatus operations practices, 4 pumping/hose testing practices, 5 SCBA/CPR training sessions, 16 Ropes/Force Entry training. Live fire at the training facility, defensive driving and many other miscellaneous training sessions, along with attending regional fire training sessions. A new recruit training class was offered through internet courses that could result in new firefighters for the department. This training was offered over several months with an additional 40 hours of practical training done at the Green River Fire Department to be State Certified as a firefighter 1.

This year we had thirteen people with over 200 training hours, four firefighters with over 300 training hours. The Fire Department honored five firefighters with 3 years of service and one with 1 year. Also honored were two firefighters with 20 years of service and two with 25 years. We also added on two new (rookie) firefighters this year. A combined total of the department we amassed a total of over **6,521** hours of documented training.

With the new formation of our Color Guard branch of the Honor Guard, we were invited to present the colors at our first home football game. The Color Guard also posted colors at our annual banquet this year. The addition of the third full time position has proven to be a benefit for the whole department. Training classes, certification of the firefighters and daily operations have proven to be more efficient for all involved.

With all of the changes over the past two years, it demanded a complete rebuild of the command structure of the Officer Corps that appears to have been a healthy and productive venture creating a renewed commitment for some officers.


