GREEN RIVER FIRE DEPARTMENT SUMMARY REPORT 2015

This report provides information regarding the activities of the Green River Fire Department. It contains information pertinent to the City of Green River and the patrons of the City. If you have any ideas or suggestions regarding additional information, please give us a call at Fire Station 2 at 872-0545.

The Department consists of up to 40 volunteers and 3 full time personnel. We respond out of two stations, Station 1 at City Hall and Station 2, located at the corner of Shoshone and Hitching Post. Our equipment is comprised of three pumpers, one pumper rescue, one quick attack rural rescue, one 93' ladder platform Aerial Truck, one Hazardous materials response trailer, one antique 1946 Fire Truck, four suburban's; one for the Fire Chief, one for the Assistant Chief, one for the Battalion Chief and the fourth that is used to transport personnel to fire schools and emergency calls and for the response of the technical rescue (rope-water) response groups.


One of the most significant occurrence's in 2015 was the ISO re-evaluation. On August 27, 2015 there was ISO re-evaluation conducted on the City of Green River. This evaluation consisted of checking fire calls, training records, maintenance records and equipment in the Fire Department and records, reports, water models of the Cities water system and the dispatch system used to notify emergency services. The results of this re-evaluation showed an improvement to a rating of 3/3X. We are among the top 8-9% of the Fire Departments in the Nation out of approximately 50,000 Departments to receive this rating. This was a joint effort for this accomplishment between the City for the Southside water project, information from the Joint Powers Water Board, Utility division for their hydrant records and maintenance, Dispatch, and the Fire Department. This improvement in rating could result in lower insurance premiums, as insurance companies use this to help determine insurance premiums in our area.

Fire incidents for 2015 showed an increase. The total Green River Fire Department's year-end report shows 299 incidents compared to 281 incidents for 2014. The 299 incidents reflect responses made by the Department including structure fires, vehicle fires, rescue/emergency medical calls, gas spills/leaks, false alarms, smoke scares, police assists, and carbon monoxide alarms.

The Fire Department responds to fires in the Jamestown and Rio-Vista under a contract with the Jamestown Fire District, and Fires and emergency incidents in Sweetwater County when called for aid. The Green River Fire Department responds to aid Castle Rock Ambulance as extrication / fire protection and special service assistance at all vehicle accidents, and extreme circumstance emergencies they are called to inside Sweetwater County and Castle


Rock Ambulance response area. We also are part of a master mutual aid agreement with County, Rock Springs, and Fire District #1.

The Fire Department responded to 299 calls in 2015 that caused an estimated property loss of approximately \$697,100.00 with a little more than half of that amount being vehicle fires. The estimated amount saved is \$910,000.00 due to the response of the fire department. Because fire is always a potential problem, the Department will continue our Fire Prevention program in our schools, churches, businesses, and service and civic organizations in an effort to lower the fire loss in the City.

During 2015, the Green River Fire Department continued to present hands-on training with the portable dry chemical fire extinguishers; Participants included employees of Castle Rock Ambulance Service, Castle Rock Medical Center, School District #2 employees as well as our own City Staff and local Day-care providers. In addition, we presented fire prevention programs to the residents of Mansface Terrace and Green Rock Village. Fire prevention programs were also presented to the local elementary schools, and station tours were conducted for many Scout groups, pre-school students and day care students. Several Infant Car Seat Inspection Sessions were held throughout the County.

Through these fire prevention and fire education programs the Green River Fire Department touched **5,404** people.

The Department also assisted at several events during Flaming Gorge Days, community events, Chamber activities, High School activities and helped with live fire training for other departments in the state of Wyoming.

The Green River Fire Department held 32 regular training meetings, 11 monthly officer staff meetings, 22 hazardous material training sessions, 12 rescue/high angle training sessions, 81 public relations/fire prevention sessions, 18 management training sessions, 19 Aerial Apparatus operations practices, 12 Swift water Rescue trainings, 2 pumping/hose testing practices, and 9 SCBA/CPR training sessions. Live fire at the training facility, defensive driving, honor guard, rookie classes and many other miscellaneous training sessions, along with attending regional fire training sessions. It was possible for firefighters to accumulate 342 paid calls during the 2015 year, 299 fire calls and 43 scheduled training meetings.

This year we had three people with over 200 training hours, one firefighter with over 400 training hours. The Fire Department honored one firefighter with 3 years of service, one firefighter with 5 years of service, one with 10 years of service, and one with 25 years of service. We also honored one Firefighter that retired in August that had 30 years of service with the Department. A combined total of the department we amassed a total of over **5,281** hours of documented training.

The Color Guard branch of the Honor Guard, were invited to present the colors at some of our home football games, the Color Guard also posted colors at our annual banquet. And still the addition of the third full time position has proven to be a tremendous benefit for the whole department. Sharing the skills of our department with other fire departments in the county, training classes, certification of the firefighters and daily operations have proven to be more efficient for all involved.


