



Fire Maintenance Technician

DEFINITION

Under general direction, perform a variety of general manual and technical tasks related to Fire Department equipment; may occasionally drive a truck.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Reports to the Assistant Fire Chief or the Fire Chief.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

Exercises no supervision.

EXAMPLES OF IMPORTANT AND ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Paint and perform annual service tests of fire hydrants.

Perform fire truck pump testing and service tests on trucks.

Perform maintenance on other fire vehicles and equipment.

OTHER JOB RELATED DUTIES

Perform other fire equipment maintenance and technical duties as assigned.

ESSENTIAL JOB RELATED QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

Labor methods and safety precautions.

Fire vehicles and equipment.

Ability to:

Follow oral and written instructions.

Perform assigned tasks properly and efficiently.

Establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and the public.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Experience and Training:

Education, training, and experience which provide the necessary skills and expertise.

License or Certification:

Possession of a valid Wyoming Class B or Class C driver's license may be required for some positions in this class.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Essential duties require the following physical skills and work environment:

Ability to stand, walk, sit, ride, climb, bend, kneel, crawl, twist, reach, grasp, push, and pull; perform heavy physical work; lift and carry 50 lbs.; and drive a vehicle. Exposure to heat, cold, and outdoors.
