DEFINITION

Under direct supervision, perform weed eradication.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Reports to the Weed Crew Leader and the Parks Division employee in charge of the program.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

No supervision exercised.

EXAMPLES OF IMPORTANT AND ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Eradicate weeds utilizing manual and motorized equipment.

Handle and use hand and power tools.

OTHER JOB RELATED DUTIES

May be assigned general unskilled work including, but not limited to, trash collection, housekeeping duties, grounds maintenance, etc.

ESSENTIAL JOB RELATED QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

Labor methods and safety precautions.

Ability to:

Properly maintain assigned areas.

Follow instructions.

Perform assigned tasks properly and efficiently.

Establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and the public.

Operate an automobile, truck, and other heavy equipment.

Communicate with citizens on a daily basis, in responding to questions or complaints.

Use various types of equipment, mowers, edgers, and hand tools.

Communicate via vehicle radios.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training:

Formal or informal education or training which ensures the ability to read and write at a level necessary for successful job performance.

Age Requirement:

Must be 18 years of age or older.

License or Certification:

A valid Wyoming, Class C driver's license is required for all positions in this class.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Essential duties require the following physical skills and work environment:

Ability to stand, walk, bend, stoop, crouch, twist, and grasp; lift or carry 50 lbs. or less; push and/or pull heavy weights (over 75 lbs.) on a regular basis; work with hands above shoulder height with up to 40 lbs.; work with arms extended at shoulder height with up to 20 lbs.; exposure to hot, cold, outdoors, mechanical hazards; and ability to travel to different sites and locations.
