



What can you RECYCLE in Green River?



At the Berto Castillon Recycle Center: 325 E Teton

- **Aluminum:** Beverage cans only – please rinse
- **Corrugated Cardboard:** Cardboard has a ripple between two layers of cardboard
- **Glass:** All types (No windows or windshields)
- **Household batteries:** Alkaline, lithium, and rechargeable
- **Newsprint/Magazines/Phone Books:** No other material please
- **Paper:** Any type of paper generated in an office with the exception of neon colors. Shredded paper (left in the bag)
- **Paperboard:** For example: cereal, pop can boxes, and egg cartons
- **Styrofoam:** Packing foam, blocks, coolers, and peanuts
- **Tin:** Cans, scrapped tin (license plates, trays, etc.) and foil accepted. Please rinse and remove all labels
- **Plastic Bags/Wrap:** Shopping bags, plastic wrap, and bubble packaging
- **Plastics # 1 & # 2**
 - Look for a tiny symbol on any plastic container
 - In the center of the symbol is a number
 - Accepted containers: 1's or 2's (**NO 3-7**)
 - Rinse container and remove lids
 - Place in the proper bin



Buy products or packages made from recycled materials: Many recycled paper products are currently on the market, including toilet tissue, paper towels, and writing paper. Some products are packaged in containers made with recycled content. Read product labels! Purchasing recycled content products helps support the recycling industry by providing a demand for the materials we place in our recycling bins, and saves energy and oil.

At the Landfill: 2005 Uinta

- **Aluminum:** See above
- **Antifreeze:** Free of oil and other contaminants. There is a charge of 25¢/gal, payable at the Scalehouse
- **Auto Batteries:** Car, truck, commercial and motorcycle
- **Corrugated Cardboard:** See above
- **Household batteries:** See above
- **Metal/Steel:** All types
- **Oil (Car and Cooking):** Do not mix with other fluids, such as brake or transmission fluid or gasoline. There is a charge of 25¢/gal, payable at the Scalehouse
- **Paint:** Latex, oil base paints, stains, and paint thinners
- **Plastics #1, and #2:** See above
- **Tin:** See above
- **White goods:** Such as, washers, dryers, grills, refrigerators/freezers (with the doors taken off)
