



What can you REUSE in Green River?



Instead of throwing unwanted items away or even before you decide to recycle something, ask yourself, “Can this be **Reused** by me or someone else?”



- **Glass** – drop off any glass at the Recycle center or the Landfill entrance and it will be crushed and used with ground cover at the Landfill. Better than using space in the Landfill with whole bottles.

- **Yard Waste** – Dump leaves, sticks and branches (less than 4 feet long), and grass into the green yard waste dumpster containers throughout town (Edgewater Park, Recycle Center, Mansface, Lincoln Middle School, Senior Center, and Railroad Ave parking lot). This is used for compost.



- **Compost** – Learn how to use your kitchen produce and yard waste to create your own compost for your flowers or garden!

- **Jars** – Reuse your peanut butter, jam, and jelly jars to organize household items like buttons, crafts, and office supplies; or garage items like nuts, bolts, and screws!



- **Plastic Food Containers** – why buy expensive containers? Reuse your yogurt, cottage cheese, and cool whip containers for leftovers. Just don't reheat food in them!
