

QUILTING ON THE GREEN 2016  
Official Rules, Information and Awards

Quilt entry forms and quilts must be submitted and received no later than Friday, May 27, 2016. Space may require limiting the number of quilts hung. Limitations will be made by postmark of entry and/or the discretion of the Show Committee. All entries must be accompanied by a nonrefundable \$5.00 fee per entry. Please make checks payable to "Quilting on the Green". All entries must have been made all or in part by person entering the quilt.

Quilts previously entered are not eligible. Tied quilts will only be accepted for exhibition or youth categories. No torn, soiled, or incomplete quilts will be accepted. All entries must have used a quilt technique, quilting and batting. Forms may be duplicated. Art quilts are exhibition ONLY.

Quilts must have a label sewn/appliquéd on the back. Quilts MUST have a generous 4" wide sleeve of fabric sewn to the top of the quilt back. Quilts without sleeves will not be accepted. However, small wall hangings and miniatures do not need a sleeve.

Quilts must be picked up on Sunday, June 5 between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. at the Expedition Island Pavilion.

Quilts being returned by mail must be accompanied with a pre-printed postage/insurance label. Quilting on the Green or its committee members will not be held responsible for quilts lost in the mail.

All precautions will be taken to assure the safety of your quilt. Please check your home owner's insurance to make certain that your quilt is covered. The security release on the entry form must be signed.

All advertising will be limited to the Quilting on the Green Committee and the show vendors. Any advertising on the entries will be removed immediately.

**Definitions:** *Wall hanging/Lap quilts* – Circumference 280 inches or less. *Bed quilts*—circumference larger than 280 inches. *Mixed technique*—use of techniques other than pieced or appliquéd and/or use of more than one technique. *ie. Pieced, appliquéd, embellished, embroidered, hand quilted, painted, or whole cloth.*

Professional status is determined if you own/operate a business and/or receive compensation from sales or teaching in the quilting profession, or you have won our Best of Show category twice.

Confident beginner, intermediate  
Pattern provided by Karen from Quilt Passions Kona, Hawaii  
Equipment and fabric requirements - Sewing machine, BSK, rotary cutter, matt, 6 x 24 inch ruler, thread  
20 strips fabric 2 ½" X WOF 2 color groups are suggested. 12 of one (ex. Blues), 8 in a similar color group (ex. Blue greens). Fabrics in each color groups should range from light to dark. I will bring some fish/turtle fabric if you would like a row of fish.  
½ yards for inner border  
1 yard for outer border  
½ yd fuseable stuff of your choice

**Judy Neimeyer's Leaf Series – Josephine de la Cruz Keasler:** The Leaf Series is a pattern that many people can complete in one day. The curved paper piecing adds the vein element to the leaf. In this class you can choose to make either the placemats or the "One" leaf wall hanging. With pieced backgrounds "One" is designed to make the leaf the focus of the project. It gives a contemporary and bold impression. Either of these projects will be a perfect as a form of wall art or a decorative feature to any decor.

### Judy Niemeyer's Leaf Series



Josephine loves teaching and she also continues to take classes from other instructors, thus enabling her to stay current in the "how to" department and, of course, to incorporate additional information when teaching others. Having made more than 110 quilts in just the past ten years, she was honored to be an Artist in Residence for Empty Spools Seminars at Asilomar in 2015. She

exhibited 40 quilts at that time, including eight designs by Quiltworx. She will be teaching at Empty Spools in 2017, and is very excited about that.

Josephine has exceptional skills in all areas of quilting including design, piecing techniques, and border options. She has an excellent awareness of color theory including value and texture, and she thoroughly enjoys assisting her students in the color/fabric selection for their projects.

As an example of her talent, expertise, and joy of teaching, in just the last year she has taught numerous classes, and has exhibited some of her quilts in shows resulting in six ribbons, including first place at HMQS for her Bali Wedding Star, National Teachers' Ribbon for Fire Island Hosta, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Professional Category for Purple Ladies and Spurs at Quilting on the Green, WY and Viewer's Choice at Quilt Wyoming 2015.

 20 strips fabric 2 1/2" x WOF 2 color groups are suggested 12 of one (ex. Blues).  
 8 in a similar color group (ex, Blue greens). Fabrics in each color groups should range from light to dark. I will bring some fish/turtle fabric if you would like a row of fish or a turtle..  
 1/4 yd for inner border  
 1 yd for outer border  
 1/4 yd fuseable stuff of your choice.

When quilts are hung prior to judging, the form submitted with the quilt is pinned wrong side up over the quilt label so that the judges cannot see any information about the quilt or the person who entered the quilt.
