**Fees:** \$130 to Green River Parks and Recreation when you register (includes WSI Manual and Swimming and Water Safety Manual).

\*Must be 16 years or older, able to tread water and back float for 1 minute and swim front crawl, back crawl, breaststroke, elementary backstroke, and sidestroke for 25 yds. each, and butterfly for 15 yds.
