A. CONSIDERATION TO AUTHORIZE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO SEEK A CHILDREN'S TRUST FUND GRANT FOR A THERAPY CANINE

The Police Department is frequently called on to interview children that are victims of a crime. These interviews are difficult and have the potential for creating additional trauma for those victim's. Detective Holzgrafe has identified programs in other states that utilize a therapy canine to assist victims during interviews and later court testimony. The Department of Family Services has identified the Children's Trust Fund Grant as a potential funding opportunity to cover the initial purchase and training of a therapy canine.

Suggested Motion: I move to authorize the Police Department to pursue a Children's Trust Fund Grant to fund initial costs for a therapy canine program.
