Consideration of a MOU regarding Child Forensic Interview Training

Background/Alternatives:

The Green River Police Department, Sweetwater County Sheriff's Office, Rock Springs Police Department and Sweetwater County Attorney's Office wish to host a Child Forensic Interview Training Course taught by the National Children's Advocacy Center on February 3-7, 2020.

Training jointly in this manner will ensure consistency in child victim interviews between all agencies utilizing recognized best practices, while building teamwork between interviewers and prosecutors that will enhance case outcomes.

Hosting the training locally is economically beneficial as it reduces the costs of travel and subsistence that would be required to obtain the training elsewhere. The proposed MOU delineates how the cost will be distributed among participating agencies.




