Dear Mayor and Council Members,

In collaboration with the Ponderosa Bar we are writing for your consideration for an Open Container Permit on June 26rd and 27th for Flaming Gorge Days. The open container would be from 9 am to 2 am on both days. The permit would include The Embassy property line and the Ponderosa property line. There will be live music starting at 9 pm continuing until one a.m. The area will be barricaded and placards will be in place. We ask that the council allows customers to be allowed to walk bar row with an open container as long as they have appropriate wrist band to mark age requirement. Adequate security will be in force throughout the night to ensure all aspects of the open container permit will be adhered to.

Due to the pandemic we will adhere the governor and city's mandates. Only 250 people will be allowed within the barricades. Masks and gloves will be offered to patrons and hand sanitizer stations will be in place for patron use. Spacing will be encouraged.

Within the bars all mandates will continue to be followed with extra staff to help with the required regulations. We will follow the governor and city's updates closely for any changes and will adjust accordingly.

We ask that the City provide the barricades.
